Introduction

Twice per year the Youth Affairs Network of Queensland's invites youth workers and youth services in Queensland to get together with their colleagues (via their local interagency¹) and share with us the high priority challenges facing young people and youth services in their region. In addition to sharing their challenges, participants are also invited to submit:

- the responses they are making, or suggest should be made to these issues;
- training needs of services in their area; and
- new programs or resources recently made available.

This report collates all the information that interagencies submitted to YANQ between **July and December 2007**. YANQ will provide a brief response/followup to some of these issues in the near future.

This process is part of the Youth Consultative Network (YCN) and aims to help Governments and the Community to learn about, and respond to the issues that effect young people (particularly those that are marginalised and disadvantaged) and youth services in Queensland. the YCN also assists youth workers to connect with others that may be working on, or concerned about similar issues.

The YCN is facilitated by Queensland's peak community youth affairs organisation, the Youth Affairs Network of Queensland (YANQ).
