# Pet Photo Competition

## TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



1. The CLA Pet Photo Competition is open to all Australian residents.
2. Entries will be accepted from Monday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2013 until midnight on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2013.
3. The competition is open to amateur photographers only.
4. The 'entrant' is deemed to be the person entering the competition, not the pet.
5. If the entrant is under the age of 18 years, permission must be gained from a parent/guardian prior to entry.
6. By entering the competition, each entrant warrants that their entry is their own original artistic work which does not infringe the rights of any third party.
7. One photo will be accepted per entry form. You may enter your photo in multiple categories if you wish.
8. More than one pet per photo is permitted provided all pets fit the description of the category/categories entered
9. With the exception of photos entered into the 'Pet that Best Resembles Owner' category, photos should include only the pet/s being entered, with no people visible.
10. Photos must only be entered if the pet is legally allowed to be kept as a pet in the state in which the photo is taken e.g. do not enter a photo of a pet rabbit taken in Queensland
11. The pet/s does not have to be owned by the entrant, but permission from the pet owner must be obtained to take the photo and submit it to this competition.
12. The photo must have no additional text or images added to it – a date stamp is permissible.
13. CLA reserves the right to refuse or not display an entry. Entries that are incomplete, indecipherable, illegible, or do not comply with these Terms and Conditions are invalid.
14. CLA may exhibit your photo and your pet's name in public during the course of the competition in both hardcopy and electronic formats. We do not guarantee that all entries will be displayed.
15. The competition will be judged by a panel of judges selected by CLA. The judge's decisions are final.
16. Finalists' photos will be displayed at the Nundah Festival prior to the winners being announced.
17. The winning photographs will be announced on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2013 at the Nundah Festival.
18. The winning photographs may remain on public display for up to two months after the event.



19. Prize winners will be notified by the preferred contact method noted on their entry forms. Prizes can be collected on the day by the winner or thereafter at CLA, 5 Nundah Street, Nundah, between 9am and 5pm, Monday to Friday.
20. Prizes are not exchangeable or redeemable for cash. In the event that CLA is no longer able to provide a prize as described for reasons outside its control, CLA may at its absolute discretion substitute some other item or items of equivalent retail value.
21. In order for entries to be valid, all entrants must provide correct payment in cash or via electronic transfer. Entries will not be valid without a completed entry form and correct payment.
22. The original digital file or film must be kept by the entrant as it may be required to demonstrate the entry is your own original work.
23. Photos entered in the competition will not be returned to you.
24. No entry should be demeaning, dangerous or culturally negative. Anything that appears to harm a pet or person or put a pet or person in a derogatory or humiliating light will not be accepted.
25. Your privacy is important to us. Personal information including name and address will only be used for the purposes and within the context of the Pet Photo Competition 2013. Any identifying information will be disposed of after the competition.
26. CLA is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, or for any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilised in this competition, or for any technical error that may occur in the course of the administration of this competition. CLA assumes no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to or alteration of entries.
27. To the full extent permitted by the law, CLA will not be liable for any injury, damages, expenses, or loss whatsoever (whether direct or inconsequential) to persons or property as a result of any person entering into the competition or accepting or using any prize, including without limitation non-receipt of any prize or damage to any prize in transit.

## PHOTO REQUIREMENTS/SPECIFICATIONS:

Please follow the instructions on the entry form to ensure you submit your entry correctly.

### HARDCOPY ENTRIES

- The hard copy of your photo must be 4x6 inches (10x15cm)
- You must write your name and your pet's name (or 'wildlife' for Best Local Wildlife Photo category) on the back of the photo



## ELECTRONIC ENTRIES

- Your photo must be in JPEG format
- The file name of your photo must be PPC[first name][last name]
- Your photo can be no larger than 4MB
- Your photo must be at least 1600 pixels wide (if horizontal) or 1600 pixels tall (if vertical)

## CATEGORY CONDITIONS:

1. **Adorable Puppy or Most Dashing Dog:** Dogs only.
2. **Cutest Kitten or Coolest Cat:** Cats only.
3. **Beautiful Bird:** All birds photographed must be domestic, belonging to an owner.
4. **Fish, Insects, Reptiles & Arachnids:** Must be a pet belonging to an owner.
5. **Best Dressed Pet:** Any pet is permitted in this category. Some sort of pet accessory/clothing is required.
6. **Pet that Best Resembles Owner:** The photo entered must include a pet and one person. Permission of the person photographed or their parent/guardian (if subject is under age of 18) must be obtained.
7. **Best Local Wildlife Photo:** Photo's are to be of a wild animal within its natural habitat and therefore does not include animals in captivity. The photo must be taken in South-East Queensland.
8. **Most 'Likes' on Facebook:** Any pet is permitted in this category. Only the photo and your pet's name will be displayed. Only one photo per entrant.
9. **Best in Show (open category):** Any living pet is permitted
10. **Unconventional Pets:** This category is for pets which do not fit within the other animal-specific categories and therefore excludes dogs, cats, birds, fish, insects, reptiles, and arachnids. Pets do not need to be living e.g. pet rock
